### A Note

In our modern age with its demands and complexities, many men are forced to “read for orders.” The primary purpose of the St. Joseph’s Summer Session is to assist men to prepare for ordination as deacons and priests in the Anglican Province of Christ the King. One important goal is to form a sense of community not just in common study with rigorous standards but also in common worship and fellowship. To that end, (permanent) deacons, priests and students from other jurisdictions are always welcome.

Mornings begin with Morning Prayer in the Chapel and both students and visiting clergy will be assigned to lead the service and read the lessons. From 10:00 a.m. to Noon, there will be a morning class followed by Mass in the Chapel. After lunch, we meet for a second class from 2:00 to 4:00 p.m.; followed by a short break and short practicum from 4:15 to 5:00 p.m. The classes will be devoted to the Liturgical Kalendar (Bishop Upham), Homiletics (Canon Jones), the Prophets (Fr. Dr. Russell) and Church History (Dr. Evans). The practicum sessions will emphasize Homiletics, Ethics and the History of the PCK/APCK. The day will conclude with Sung Evensong in the Chapel. During evenings to be selected, However, we will gather to watch two videos (*Monsignor Quixote* and *Between Two Worlds*) which will form part of the practicum on Ethics.

The fee for the two-week session is \$300 (or \$150 for one week) which includes housing. Meals are “on your own” but we have a kitchen and dining area available.
